

INDO-ARGENTINE BILATERAL SCIENTIFIC COOPERATION (DST- MINCYT)

CALL FOR PROPOSALS - 2011

From 15th March to 15th May, 2011 is the open call for the presentation of joint research projects between Indian and Argentine groups, in the framework of Science and Technology Cooperation Programme (POC) 2009-2011, signed on 14th October, 2009 between the Department of Science and Technology of the Indian Republic and the Ministry of Science, Technology and Productive Innovation from the Argentine Republic, taking as a base of the General Agreement about Scientific and Technical Cooperation between Indian Government and Argentine Government in 1985.

OBJECTIVES:

- To strengthen and to expand relations between both scientific communities, making possible the
 exchange between Indian and Argentine I+D groups, in the framework of joint scientific and
 technological projects, selected by the parties.
- Promote the implementation of joint projects able to bound I+D centres with enterprises from both countries.

ELIGIBILITY / PROJECT PARTICIPANTS AND SUBJECT AREAS:

Faculty, Scientists and Academicians belonging to Universities, Deemed Universities and Research Institutes having permanent positions can apply as Principal Investigator (PI). In order to qualify for such funding, investigators are required to have a concrete and sound research proposal on any of the following areas:

The priority areas for this Call as were mutally agreed are given below:

- Biotechnology applied to Agri-food security and safety
- Oceanography and Polar Research
- Medical and Health
- Agriculture and related technologies
- Information Technologies
- Technology Incubators and Productive innovation
- Science Popularization and communication

WAYS OF COOPERATION:

A joint research project of 3 year duration is established by two or more research groups from India and Argentina, with objectives to be achieved during the timetable established, implemented through the exchange of researchers. The projects must be supported by the Project Investigator (PI)/directors (one from

India and one from Argentina) properly qualified for directing research and present guarantees for financial resources. Each Pl/director must submit the completed forms to the office in charge of the cooperation in his country. The submission must be simultaneous in both countries, otherwise they will not be considered.

The applicants must agree in all terms and must include both Pls/directors conformity

DURATION OF THE VISITS/ MISSIONS:

short missions: up to 15 days
intermediate missions: 21 days
long missions: 1, 2 or 3 months

FUNDING:

The grants-in-aid/subsidies given by DST & MINCYT will be used/addressed exclusively to cover the trip between India and Argentina of researchers affected to specific tasks of the project. The International Travel cost for the scientists including overseas medical insurance, airport taxes will be borne by the sending side including the transportation from the capital city/arrival city to the place of visiting institute(s).

The local hospitality terms for visiting scientists in each others' host country are as follows:

For Indian researchers: paid accommodation (by the receiving institution) and a daily allowance of Argentine Peso (\$) 340 per day in case of short mission up to 15 days, \$ 5,200 for intermediate missions of 21 days and \$ 6,000 per month missions of more than 21 days duration.

For Argentine researchers: paid accommodation (in a Guest House/Hotel with reasonable amenities) and a daily allowance of Rs.1,000/- per day in case of short term visit (up to 21 days) and Rs. 25,000/- per month in case of long term visit (more than 21 days) towards food and out of pocket allowances.

The missions must be indicated in the form, properly justified, with duration (days) and names of researchers involved. The project approval from both sides will imply the approval of the missions as they are included in the application forms or as indicated in the Bilateral Act. The Indian and Argentine Pls/Directors of the project must present at the end of the first period of the project, an activity report attaching the publications generated. This will be the base for approving next year exchanges.

PROJECT SELECTION

An internal evaluation procedure will be followed in each country after the last date of receipt of the proposals i.e May 15, 2011. Indo-Argentine Joint Committee on S&T (JCST) will make the final "bilateral" selection of the proposals, taking into consideration the evaluation from both sides. The results will be published in a Bilateral Act to be concluded at the JCST meeting. This decision is indisputable. Projects as recommended by the JCST will only be co-financed by the Indian and Argentine Authorities to be implemented under the Indo-Argentine Programme of Cooperation signed up by the MINCYT - DST.

APPLICATION PROCEDURE:

Joint research projects in the **prescribed format** duly forwarded by the Head of the Institutions are to be submitted simultaneously, by the Indian Project Leader to the Department of Science and Technology, New Delhi and, by the Argentinean Project Leader to the Ministry of Science, Technology and Productive Innovation. **Applications received by both the agencies with all necessary documents shall only be considered**.
